Agricultural Plastic Waste Recycling Rules

Dirty or contaminated plastic is not recyclable. We therefore ask our customers to use the following simple rules when storing waste to ensure everything we collect can be re-used.

Every type of plastic must be stored separately. Mixing plastics will increase the cost of this service by creating additional sorting. Keep your bags suitably covered to keep the waste dry.

Silage Wrap & Silage Clamp Sheet

Ideally, hose off any silage / mud, hang up to dry then store in your waste bag as this would be extremely helpful. However, we realize this is not always practical but please ensure your plastic is as clean and dry as possible.

Crop Cover & Polytunnels

When removed from the field, please ensure the product is stored either immediately in the waste bags or on a clean and dry surface.

Feed Bags – i.e. 25 kgs

Shake as much residue out of the bags as possible and place immediately in your waste bag.

Feed, Seed, Fertilizers Bags – i.e. 500 / 600 kgs

Shake as much residue out of the bags as possible and place immediately in your waste bag. There is **no** need to split double skinned bags.

Plastic Spray Cans, Containers, Dairy Drums, Pesticide or Herbicide Drums, Milk Lick Buckets, Wormer Containers.

Must be triple rinsed, with metal handles and foil caps removed. Puncture the container if easier and you can squash the container to maximize the space in your waste bag. Include plastic bucket lids and handles.

Net Wrap / String.

We have a recycling outlet for these materials however as the materials are different they have to be collected in **separate** waste bags.

Other Miscellaneous – i.e. foil caps, metal handles, grease cartridges etc.

Meat handles – place in a 25kg bag. Foil caps, grease cartridges etc are classed as Hazardous Waste and we can supply approved burn boxes for storage and collection. Telephone us for more details.

Recycling Do's and Don'ts

1. Please sort your waste into categories e.g.

- String
- Net
- Fertilizer bags
- Cardboard and paper
- Buckets and containers
- Feed bags
- Silage wrap and sheet



If you are uncertain, please call us as we want to avoid this sort of thing:-



2. Please remove spray can foils and cardboard caps as these are classed as hazardous waste - place in your hazardous waste container.



3. Please ensure that you triple rinse ALL chemical containers before placing them into the bag. This is the farmer's responsibility and if it is not done can cause serious harm to other people!

NOTE – All bags are numbered and if we have an issue we can trace it to the farm it came from.
